I always tighten more that I need and those little things get broken like butter, they cost around \$2 but I refuse to pay to the stealer that and have to wait 10 days to get them.

So I found out this came perfect and will reduce the vibration on the speedo big time.

What you need, they call this thing Nu-seal washer #6 any Ace hardware has them at the pluming section and a 5mm nut \$0.10.

- 1- take the plastic thing out of the rubber washer
- 2- Make a hole on bottom
- 3- put it in the holder
- 4-put the nut into the washer and you got it, you can crazy glue it if you want I didn't, cause if you over tighten it the nut comes off and you just put it back again even like this you can tighten it more than with the stock set up.
